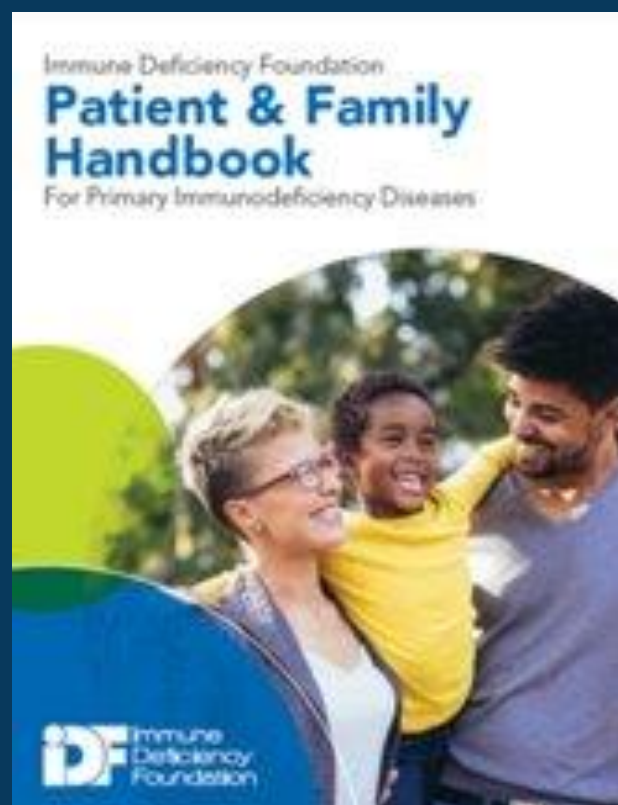

IDF has long maintained a database of clinicians who specialize in the treatment of primary immunodeficiency (PI). Our online tool can help connect patients with a local PI specialist.



### For Patients

Finding a provider with primary immunodeficiency (PI) expertise can be difficult. Navigating diagnosis, testing, treatment, and insurance coverage makes the process even more difficult. Use IDF's Clinician Finder to access a list of clinicians who specialize in the treatment of PI.

### For Clinicians

Clinician Finder is an opportunity to be listed on the IDF website so patients can find more information about your expertise. No matter your particular specialty, if you have expertise in treating patients with PI, consider requesting your practice be listed so that families can find the expertise they need.
